Notice is hereby given that sealed bid proposals will be received by Kenmore City Clerk at the Kenmore City Hall, 18120 68th Avenue NE, PO Box 82607, Kenmore, Washington, 98028. **Bids are due no later than 2:00:00 PM EXACTLY, Pacific local time**, according to the clock at the City's Front Reception Desk, **August 11, 2016**, at which time bids for the above referenced project will be opened and publicly read. Bid proposals received after this date and time will not be considered.

The City of Kenmore seeks a contractor to furnish all labor, materials and equipment necessary to complete the project referenced above. **The work shall include, but is not limited to, furnishing all labor, equipment, and materials necessary to construct approximately 460 linear feet of sidewalk on the north side of NE 181st ST between 68th Ave NE and 73rd Ave NE in the City's downtown area. Improvements include but are not limited to new curb and gutter, HMA overlay, sidewalk, modular block wall, storm drainage, street trees and grates, irrigation, and illumination system, consistent with existing downtown improvements west of the project area.**

All bidding shall be based upon compliance with the Contract Plans and Contract Provisions.

The estimated construction cost: \$385,000.
