**PUBLIC HEARING ON COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AND MUNICIPAL  
CODE AMENDMENTS RELATED TO CRITICAL AREAS  
PROTECTION AND THE SHORELINE MASTER PROGRAM.**

Notice is hereby given that the City of Kenmore Planning Commission will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, March 26, 2019, 7:00 p.m., at Kenmore City Hall, Council Chambers, 18120 68<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE, on amendments related to protection of critical areas (streams, wetlands, geologically hazardous areas, flood hazard areas, etc.) and standards for development on the shorelines of Lake Washington, the Sammamish River and Swamp Creek. Among other things, the amendments align the City's rating systems for wetlands and streams to those used by the State, prohibit development in high landslide hazard areas, and revise shoreline buffers along the Sammamish River and Swamp Creek.
