


# Maintaining Vegetation



The City of Kenmore needs your help to keep sidewalks, walkways and roadways safe and accessible for everyone! Property owners are responsible for maintaining trees, bushes and other vegetation on their property and in the right of way adjacent to their property. Please keep up with your trimming and contact the City if you have questions or concerns.

Property owners must keep roadways, bicycle lanes, sidewalks and walking paths (4 feet minimum width) clear of vegetation. Roadways must be clear to a height of 11 feet and other traveled ways\* clear to a height of 8 feet. At intersections, there should be no obstruction, including but not limited to vegetation, between 42 inches and 8 feet above the existing street grade to allow sight distance. Ditches must be allowed to flow freely. Trimming of vegetation in the right of way is the responsibility of property owners.

\* Traveled ways are defined "by the edge stripe or edge of pavement where no stripe is present"
