



While focused on the near term, we are mindful to work toward a fully functional, great neighborhood park in the long term (3+ years).





Answered: 45 Skipped: 1





Answered: 46 Skipped: 0





WHERE DO YOU LIVE?



- wayfinding ^{education}
- parking? (church lot? street?)
- sight lines (driving)
- upper woods - trails
- If dog parks are necessary keep them to a defined area / fenced area.
- fish pond / habitat / educational
- visual access to pond (birding)
- paths through buffers (low impact)
- features that have little (?) impact on existing wildlife in forest (deer?)
- flowers
- dark sky approved led path lighting
- Keep a neighborhood park → NOT a destination park → Yes
- Loop/path around park Yes ↑ **↑ YES!**
- trail connection to bothell park
- **↑ YES!** playground
- Access w/ no bus or SIDEWALK.
- Don't be redundant with THINGS ALREADY IN OTHER PARKS ^{→ keep park features unique to land}
- GIVE A REASON FOR PEOPLE TO DRIVE TO PARK. Prefer to keep it a walk / local park ^{to}
- Keep lighting to a min ^{or no lighting to appreciate night's sky}
- respectful of sport court hrs.
- DON'T DUPLICATE WHAT IS NEARBY ^{agree ↓}
 - 1. PLAYGROUND - 7 BLS. AWAY AT KENMORE ELEMENTARY (JUST REQUIRES COOPERATION IN THE W/ MOORLANDS)
 - 2) DOG/WATER PLAY AREA - 5 BLS AWAY AT SWAMP CREEK PARK
 - 3) FIELDS-SPORTS - NEXT DOOR AT DOUG ALLEN
- Workout station
- sidewalk access @ 80th st.
- crosswalk @ 80M (accessible) / speed bumps (defensible pedestrian row)

The Vision | Your Voice...

Emerging Themes:

- The natural character is important, and ecology and nature are a valued program for the park.
- Do not overdevelop the site with intensive elements.
- The traffic and speed of 80th is a challenge to park access and success.
- A neighborhood park, not a destination park.
- There is not a designated dog park in Kenmore. Is this the place? (If so, a long-term improvement.)
- Access to the wetlands (buffers).

The Vision | Your Voice...

Insight nuggets!

- Can the site be irrigated with reclaimed water from Brightwater?
- To fence or not to fence? (neighbors)
- Consider parking in tandem with the adjacent church.
- Incorporate traffic calming to 80th, speed bumps, and rapid-flash beacons at crosswalks/intersections.
- The forest had trails and should have them again, perhaps “self-forming.”
