



# PAVEMENT SEALING FINAL NOTICE

**Several roads in your neighborhood will be completely closed for pavement sealing. EXPECT A ONE DAY ROAD CLOSURE BETWEEN AUGUST 5TH AND 7TH FROM 7AM - 5PM SEE BACK FOR PROJECT MAP AND DETAILED SCHEDULE**

**When? August 5th and 7th** (weather dependent). In the event of wet weather, work may be rescheduled.

**Why?** Pavement sealing will extend the life of your road for a fraction of the price of asphalt overlay.

## WHAT TO EXPECT:

- **On the day of the pavement sealing, your road may be closed for several hours any time between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. The street will not be ready to use until 5 p.m. on the day of pavement sealing.** During this time you will not be able to drive through or park in the construction area or on the new road surface. If cars are still parked on the street when the crews show up to work, **cars will be towed at owner's expense. Please plan travel and parking in advance.**
- Each street segment (see map on back) will close for one day only.
- Street Segments B25 - B36 are not receiving pavement sealing and will not have full road closures, but will have parking restrictions advertised in advance of pavement making.
- "No Parking" signs will be out 24-48 hours in advance of road closure; vehicles parked in work areas on the day of pavement sealing will be towed *at owner's expense*.
- NO mail or deliveries will be made while the road is closed.
- Emergency vehicles will have access as needed.
- Regular garbage service will not be disrupted and garbage pick up days were taken into consideration when creating the schedule.
- The day pavement sealing takes place, you'll see, hear, and experience construction activity.
- You may see or feel bits of aggregate on the road, but they should not damage your vehicle. The road will be swept several times after the treatment.
- Your road may appear and feel a little bumpy and rough at first, but over time it will start to smooth out and return to normal roughness.
- We know this will be an inconvenience and we are doing what we can to minimize it. Thank you for your patience!
