

1/23/24 Answers to Questions Received 1/22/24

1. We are looking for clarification on the land survey component - will a wetland delineation report including GIS with submeter accuracy be sufficient or do you require a land survey conducted by a licensed surveyor?

Addendum 1 removes Land Surveyor qualifications and proposed work from RFP 23-C2991.

- As confirmed by regulatory agency representatives, GPS and GIS tools are sufficiently accurate enough to capture the wetland delineation for ʔaʔwadis (Ti' awh-ah-dees) Park Water Access Project. Year 5 monitoring report.

2. Under Task 2.4 deliverables, is CAD required or will GIS suffice?

Based on the regulatory agency confirmation to Question 1 above, Task 2.4 Deliverable for Final Survey is hereby amended to read:

- Final Survey (pdf and GIS Vector Shapefile) for each project site.

3. Regarding the Volunteer Stewardship services – will this be supplementary to routine park maintenance or is the stewardship intended to provide all maintenance?

RFP 23-C2991 does not include Routine Maintenance.

4. Does this statement below apply only after award, to the winning team? Section 1.5 on Page 2 states: *1.5 RFP CONTRACT: RFP #23-C2991 scope of work and associated cost proposal shall use the following Contract Template: Attachment A Contract No. 23-C2991 Template: Monitoring, Reporting and Stewardship Support Services (Consultant Professional Services).*

Please refer to Section 1.3 SCHEDULE for timing of use of Contract after Selection.

5. Please clarify whether we are to use Exhibit A from Attachment A in our proposal to describe our approach and budget, or rather are we to base our approach and budget off the outline provided on RFP Page 13 Section 3.6 "Figure 5, Approach and Budget Response Format"?

Use Figure 5 in Section 3.6 to submit RFP proposed scope and budget.

6. Under submittal requirements, Section 3.5, shall the 5 completed representative projects include projects of the Land Surveyor, or can the Land Surveyor on a team feature up to 5 additional projects?

Section 3.5 Submittal Requirements as been amended per Addendum 1 to read:

3.5 Recent Project Examples: Submit a representative of prior project examples in Washington State within the last five years with examples of work performed. For each of the projects, include the name, title, and phone number of a responsible, local reference associated or familiar with the project:

- No more than five (5) completed projects providing Monitoring and Reporting services.
- On more than five (5) completed projects providing Volunteer Stewardship services.
