**Rebate Terms:**

- Rebate is available only for Kenmore residents who are contracting for residential solar install on property within Kenmore, through Solarize Kenmore 2025. Participants are encouraged to submit application for rebate upon contract signing. Applications submitted after project completion are also acceptable. Installation work must be completed before the rebate check will be issued by the City of Kenmore. A maximum of one rebate per applicant and residential address is allowed.
  - Cancelled contracts, installations completed outside of the program, late submittals beyond the rebate timeline, and non-Kenmore residents or non-Kenmore properties are not eligible for rebate.
  - Rebate shall not exceed cost of installation.
  - Application must be submitted and approved by the City of Kenmore along with documentation of completed work, including but not limited to executed contract, receipts, invoices, etc. The installation must be completed by June 1, 2026 to qualify for rebate.
  - Verification of project completion may be conducted by the City of Kenmore through the program installers. The City reserves the right to inspect the property for compliance prior to issuance of the rebate.
  - Applications for rebate are only available March 1, 2025 to July 1, 2026 or until solar installation funds are exhausted, whichever occurs first. The City has the sole discretion to terminate the program if funds are exhausted.
  - Rebate will be awarded to qualified applicants on a first come, first served basis as determined by the date of contract signing.
  - Rebate will be issued in the form of a check to the name and address on the application. Upon approval of application, please allow up to 4 weeks for processing, which may require additional information being submitted to the City.
  - Rebate may qualify as taxable income. Consult your tax advisor for details.
- ☐ I understand that rebate programs have limited funds and shall terminate upon depletion of program funding.
