## City of Kenmore – Updated Procedure for Utility Work Permitting Effective July 1, 2025

The City of Kenmore and Northshore Utility District (NUD) are streamlining permitting processes for water and sewer work within the public right-of-way (ROW). This update improves coordination, eliminates redundant permits, and supports timely project delivery.

### What's Changing?

Beginning July 1, 2025, NUD will no longer apply for separate Franchise Utility ROW Permits for projects that are part of a development with an active Engineering Permit Application. Instead, utility work will be reviewed and permitted as part of the existing development permit<sup>1</sup>. For standalone utility work (not associated with development), NUD will continue to apply separately through the City's Engineering Department.

### Review & Inspections

- **NUD** continues to inspect utility work and provide review feedback to the City.
- **City inspectors** confirm compliance with approved plans and verify NUD inspections.
- **Deviations** from approved plans require City approval.

### Summary

This update:

- Eliminates duplicative permits for development-related utility work
- Clarifies roles and points of contact
- Supports faster, more efficient project coordination
